Currently there's no way to use proxy fields in the model admin for some items such as raw_id_fields: the ModelAdmin doesn't validate because it can't find the field using _meta.get_field(). I think this is related to the issues that django 1.3 has with proxy fields (ticket <a href="#">#71</a> ) but I'm not sure yet.

This is semi-resolved with commit 3ffa19cadab3f60f7b0781aac87b17365837c4b0.
